**Busan**

Busan, formerly known as Pusan, and is now officially Busan Metropolitan City and is South Korea's second most-populous city after Seoul, with a population of over 3.5 million inhabitants. It is the economic, cultural and educational center of southeastern Korea. Its port is Korea's busiest and the 9th-busiest in the world and is located only about 120 miles (190 km) from the Japanese islands of Kyushu and Honshu. The surrounding "Southeast Economic Zone" (including Ulsan and South Gyeongsang) is now South Korea's largest industrial area.

**Background**

This conference is a continuation of the preceding fourteen conferences that have been held in the name of Asian International Conference on Fluid Machinery (AICFM). From the fourth conference (1993) on, it has expanded into an Asian international conference though the start was held in Japan and China.

The fifth to fourteenth conferences were held in Seoul (1997), Johor Bahru (2000), Fukuoka (2003) Yichang (2005), Jeju (2007), Kuala Lumpur (2009), Chennai (2011), Yogyakarta (2013), Tokyo (2015), and Zhenjiang (2017). Asian Fluid Machinery Committee (AFMC) was established during the 9th AICFM 2007 held in Jeju, Korea.

At the upcoming conference, keynote lectures, delivered by worldwide fluid machinery specialists, will introduce the outstanding achievements in various fluid machinery areas. The conference is organized by AFMC. Participation of those who are relevant to every facet of fluid machinery R&D will be encouraged.

The AICFM15 is co-organized by Asian Fluid Machinery Committee (AFMC) and Korean Society for Fluid Machinery (KSFN). Just prior to the AICFM15 (September 25-27, 2019), IAHR-Asia 2019 will be collocated between September 24 and 25, 2019.

- To encourage partnership between academia and industry
- To discuss the role of fluid machinery in light of sustainable development, depletion of conventional energy sources and environmental challenges
